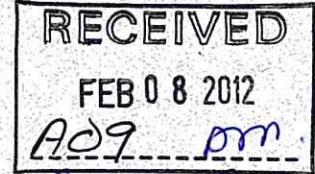

Board By-Law 284-2008, establishes guidelines for members of the Niagara Regional Police Service who participate in secondary activities unrelated to their employment with the Police Service. Section 4.1 of the By-Law requires that the Chief of Police report to the Police Service's Board annually on disclosures made in this regard and the decision made by the Chief.

The following disclosures and decisions were made in 2011:
