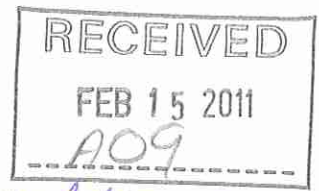

Background:

**.BY-LAW NO. 186-99 a By-Law Respecting Fundraising for Service Related
Organizations states the following:**



1. **PREAMBLE** 1.1 *"Whereas certain organizations are permitted by the Board to use the NRPS name and logo..."*

2. **DEFINITIONS** 2.6 *"Fundraising" means the solicitation of money for the benefit of a Service Related Organization and not the Service, and the sale of goods, services or licences by the Service Related Organization for the purpose of raising money for the benefit of that organization."*

2.11 *"Service Related Organization" means any individual group, club, team or organization which is comprised wholly or in part of Service Members and which uses the name or logo of the Service as part of its name, or which holds out as related to the Service."*

3. **APPLICATION** 3.1 *"This by-law applies to*

3.1.1 *Fundraising by Service Related Organizations*

3.1.3 *the receipt and/or disbursement of any monies received on account of Fundraising by Service Related Organizations*

4. RESTRICTIONS

4.3 *"The Board shall not approve any Fundraising proposal which may in the opinion of the Board compromise the integrity, objectivity or impartiality of the Service."*

5. FUNDRAISING

5.1 *"This Article applies to any Fundraising initiative undertaken by a Service Related Organization in which the total money proposed to be raised exceeds \$5,000.*

5.2 *"No such Fundraising shall be undertaken without prior Board approval."*

It should be noted that the only monies to be received by *Welland/Pelham Association for Community Living* are to cover the costs associated to hosting the Conference. It is not anticipated that any additional monies will be received.

FUNDRAISING in 2010

Over the past twelve months members of the Niagara Regional Police Service have been involved in several fundraising events throughout the region. Such organizations such as Community Care Food Drive, Special Olympics, the United Way, Toys for Tots, Women's Place, and Victim's Services have all benefited from members of the Service donating their time and money in support. Although these organizations have benefited from the work and dedication of our membership the members efforts did not require reporting through the Niagara Regional Police Service under By-Law per By-Law 186-99. Therefore there were no requests made during 2010.
