



BY-LAW NO. 315-2011
A BY-LAW TO AMEND LICENCING BY-LAW 300-2010

1. PREAMBLE

- 1.1 WHEREAS the Regional Municipality of Niagara (the "Region") has authority to pass by-laws applicable to one or more of the area municipalities to licence, regulate and govern the various trades, callings, businesses and occupations pursuant to Section 151(1) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25 (the "Act");
- 1.2 AND whereas pursuant to By-law 8916-97, the Region has delegated to the Regional Municipality of Niagara Police Services Board (the "Board") its power to licence and regulate various trades, callings, businesses and occupations;
- 1.3 AND whereas the Board has enacted By-law 300-2010 to licence, regulate and govern the various trades, callings, businesses and occupations mentioned in Section 3 of By-law 300-2010;
- 1.4 AND whereas the Board wishes to amend By-law 300-2010;
- 1.5 AND whereas pursuant to the delegated authority from the Region, the Board hereby enacts the following as By-law No. 315-2011, being a by-law to amend By-law 300-2010, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA POLICE SERVICES BOARD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 2 SECTION 2.v. of By-law 300-2010, being the definition of "passenger" is hereby deleted.

3 ENACTMENT

- 3.1 This By-law shall come into effect on the day it is passed.
